

**PETITION FOR A FACULTY WAIVER
TYLER JUNIOR COLLEGE
ASSOCIATE DEGREE NURSING EDUCATION PROGRAM**

SUMMARY OF REQUEST:

Consider the petition from Tyler Junior College Associate Degree Nursing Education Program for a non-emergency faculty waiver on behalf of Paula Evette Teagle, BSN, RN and the recommendation from the Education Liaison Committee (ELC) regarding the petition.

HISTORICAL PERSPECTIVE:

- The rule specifies that nursing faculty shall hold a master's degree or doctorate degree, preferably in nursing.
- Ms. Teagle has been employed as a nursing faculty member at Tyler Junior College in the Associate Degree Nursing Education Program for the past academic year under an emergency faculty waiver which expired in August, 2006.
- Ms .Teagle is enrolled in a masters nursing program and has completed 11 semester credit hours of a 42 semester credit hour masters degree program in nursing.
- The program submitted the necessary letter and supporting documentation requesting the non-emergency faculty waiver and board staff conducted a review of the materials.
- Current policy requires that a petition for a non-emergency faculty waiver be referred to the ELC for review and recommendation if the proposed faculty member has not completed at least 75% of the required semester credit hours of a masters degree program.

PROS AND CONS:

Pros:

- Ms. Teagle I is an experienced nursing faculty as she has been a nursing faculty member at Tyler Junior College Associate Degree Nursing Program for the past academic year on an emergency faculty waiver granted to the program.
- A review of the petition and the supporting documentation revealed that all criteria for approval of the non-emergency waiver on behalf of Ms. Teagle I have been met with the exception of completion of 75% of the required semester hours of masters degree program.
- Ms.Teagle has completed 11 semester credit hours of a 33 semester credit hour masters degree program in nursing and was enrolled for 6 semester credit hours at the time the waiver was sought.
- Currently, the program does not have any non-emergency faculty waivers in place.

Cons:

- Mentoring for Ms. Teagle and five new faculty members is ongoing.

ELC RECOMMENDATION:

The ELC reviewed the petition and supporting documentation and a majority of the members voted to recommend approval of the non-emergency faculty waiver for Paula Teagle, BSN, RN. Temporary approval of a non-emergency faculty waiver was granted to the program until the Board considers the petition at a regularly scheduled Board Meeting (See Attachment One).

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

Move to ratify the recommendation from the ELC to approve the non-emergency faculty waiver for Paula Teagle, BSN, RN, to be a nursing faculty member for the Associate Degree Nursing Education Program at Tyler Junior College, as indicated in the attached letter (See Attachment Two).
