

**CONSIDERATION OF PROPOSED CHANGE IN APPROVAL STATUS
 BASED ON THE NCLEX-RN® EXAMINATION PASS RATES FOR
 THE FIRST GRADUATING CLASS**

**TOMBALL COLLEGE
 ASSOCIATE DEGREE NURSING EDUCATION PROGRAM**

SUMMARY OF REQUEST:

Consider staff recommendation concerning a proposed change in the approval status for Montgomery College Associate Degree Nursing Education Program based on review of the NCLEX-RN® Examination pass rates for the first graduating class.

HISTORICAL PERSPECTIVE:

Year	Approval Status	NCLEX-PN® Pass Rate	Number of First-Time Candidates (Passed/Total)
July 2005	Granted Initial Approval	Enrolled 40 students in program on 8/29/05	
May 2007	Initial	First class graduated May, 2007 Preliminary results available - 92.11%	35/38

- Tomball College Associate Degree was granted approval to begin an associate degree nursing program and placed on Initial status by the Board of Nurse Examiners in July 2005. The students enrolled in the program on August 29, 2005.
- Forty students graduated in May of 2007. Thirty eight graduates have tested. The NCLEX-RN® results for the graduating class are as identified above.
- Assuming failure of the two students, the NCLEX-RN® pass rate for the first class would be above the required 80%.

PROS AND CONS:

Pros:

- The program director and faculty have conducted an analysis of the program to identify strengths and weaknesses. Corrective measures have been implemented.
- Attrition has been minimal in the program (38/40 graduates).

Cons:

- None noted

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

Move to change the Initial approval status of the Tomball College Associate Degree nursing education program to Full in accordance with rule 215. 4 related to Approval as noted in the attached letter (Attachment one).
