

Adoption of Rule Reviews of chapters 211, 217, 219 and 223

Section 2001.039 of the Texas Government Code requires each agency to review each of its rules every four (4) years and consider whether to re-adopt, re-adopt with amendments, or repeal each rule. The proposed reviews of chapter 211 (**General Provisions**), chapter 217 (**Licensure, Peer Assistance and Practice**), chapter 219 (**Advanced Nurse Practitioner Program**), and chapter 223 (**Fees**) were posted in the July 13, 2007, *Texas Register* (attached) and were done pursuant to this statutory requirement. These rules are continuously assessed to determine whether the reason(s) for originally adopting these chapters continues to exist. Each section of these chapters is continually reevaluated to determine whether it is obsolete, reflects current legal and policy considerations, reflects current procedures and practices of the Board, and/or whether it is in compliance with chapter 2001 of the Texas Government Code (The Administrative Procedure Act).

The public had thirty (30) days to comment on the rule reviews and to submit any response or suggestions. No comments were received. On October 5, 2007, the adoption of the rule reviews for the aforementioned chapters was published in the *Texas Register* (not available at the time of submission). No action is required by the Board.

These rule reviews begin the Board's rule review plan for 2007 - 2011 that is available on the Secretary of State's web site.
