

**Report of 2010 NCLEX-PN® Examination Pass Rates
for Vocational Nursing Education Programs**

Summary:

The period between January 1 and ending December 31 is used for the purposes of determining programs' NCLEX-PN® examination pass rates. This report provides final 2010 NCLEX® examination pass rates of first time test-takes in the vocational nursing education programs in Texas. Programs with an asterisk are commended for their pass rate of 90% or above. New programs who have not graduated a class will not be included in the report since NCLEX® examination results are not available for them. Rule 215.4(c) states that "Approval status is determined biennially by the Board on the basis of the program's compliance audit, NCLEX-PN® examination pass rate, and other pertinent data." Continuing approval letters were sent to programs in July 2010 for two years.

Programs with a pass rate below 80% for one year will be required to submit a self-study report to board staff according to the guidelines. Programs with a pass rate below 80% for two consecutive years may be placed on full approval with warning. Programs experiencing a third year of pass rates below 80% may be placed on conditional approval.
