

**Report of Teach Out Plan
Cisco College in Abilene, Texas
Associate Degree Nursing Program**

Summary of Request:

Consider the teach out plan for current nursing students in the Associate Degree Nursing Education Program at Cisco College in Abilene, Texas.

Historical Perspective:

- The Associate Degree Nursing Education Program at Cisco College in Abilene, Texas, began as an LVN to RN Mobility Track in 1995.
- In July 2005, the Board granted initial approval to a new generic AND program, and in 2009, the generic and mobility tracts were combined into one program.
- The NCLEX-RN® examination pass rates for the past four years have been below 80%.
- The program's approval status was changed from Full with Warning to Conditional at the April 2011 Board meeting, and the Board withdrew approval from the program at the January 2012 meeting.
- The program was required to submit to Board Staff a teach-out plan for the currently enrolled students.
- There were 61 students at the time of the survey visit in November and 57 remain. Two students failed the fall semester and two withdrew because of family responsibilities.
- The teach out plan provided by Cisco College is attached (Attachment #1).

4. RNSG 2360 Clinical III will include:
 - A. Students being assigned at both Hendrick Medical Center and Abilene Regional Medical Center
 - B. Requirement of taking care of 2-3 patients
 - C. Clinical Paperwork (Care Plans, Nurses notes, Patient assessments, Concept maps)
 - D. Teaching plan (Rubric for evaluation of teaching plan)
 - E. Clinical Rubric evaluation tool
 - F. Mid-Clinical evaluation (Evaluation Tool)
 - G. Final Clinical evaluation (Evaluation Tool)
 - H. Post conference
5. RNSG 2130 Professional Nursing Review/Licensure Preparation will include:
 - A. Online reading assignments (Texas Board of Nursing web pages)
