

**ELIGIBILITY AND DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE REPORT FOR
February 13, 2018 and March 13, 2018**

The Eligibility and Disciplinary Committee (Committee) convened on February 13, 2018 and March 13, 2018. This report collectively summarizes the matters and decisions made at the time of the meeting¹.

Petitioners for Licensure

No petitions for licensure were considered by the Committee.

Petitioners for an Exception to a Previous Board Order

The Committee considered fourteen (13) petitions for an exception to a previous board order:

1. Petitioner requested an Exception to a previous Board Order dated March 8, 2016, requesting employment requirement be deemed satisfied with the completion of three (3) quarters. It was the Committee's decision to **deny** the request.
2. Petitioner requested an Exception to a previous Board Order dated December 30, 2014, requesting unencumbered licenses. It was the Committee's decision to **deny** the request. The Committee decided if Petitioner submitted a fitness to practice evaluation the Executive Director could make a determination or opt to request Petitioner to appear before the Committee again.
3. Petitioner requested an Exception to a previous Board Order dated September 8, 2015, requesting the limitation of her recognition as a Family Nurse Practitioner be lifted and prescriptive authority be reinstated. Petitioner withdrew her request to lift the limitation of her recognition as a Family Nurse Practitioner. It was the Committee's decision to **grant** her request to reinstate her prescriptive authority with the stipulation that she prescribe no controlled substances for the first year.
4. Petitioner requested an Exception to a previous Board Order dated December 13, 2016, requesting she be allowed to enter the KSTAR program. It was the Committee's decision to **grant** a modification to the order with the following stipulations: Petitioner must successfully complete the RN refresher course and Critical Thinking course, notify employers of the order and stipulations, submit notification of employment forms, submit performance evaluations, be subject to direct supervision the first year, and indirect supervision the second year.

5. Petitioner requested an Exception to a previous Board Order dated February 23, 2016, requesting she be allowed to enter EEP in lieu of TPAPN. It was the Committee's decision to **grant** the request.
6. Petitioner requested an Exception to a previous Board Order dated November 14, 2017, requesting she be given credit for courses completed under her previous board order and be granted an unencumbered license. It was the Committee's decision to **grant** the request to be given credit for previously completed courses but to deny her request for an unencumbered license.
7. Petitioner requested an Exception to a previous Board Order May 10, 2016, requesting she be allowed to provide direct patient care unsupervised. Petitioner was offered a proposed Board Order to allow her to go back to direct patient care with stipulations. Petitioner requested the supervision requirement be removed from the proposed Board Order. It was the Committee's decision to agree with the proposed Board Order as offered and to **deny** Petitioner's request.
8. Petitioner requested an Exception to a previous Board Order dated January 21, 2016, requesting the requirement to attend support group meetings twice a week be reduced to once a week. It was the Committee's decision to **grant** the request.
9. Petitioner requested an Exception to a previous Board Order dated April 21, 2016, requesting an unencumbered license. It was the Committee's decision to **grant** modification to no longer submit to random drug screens for the remainder of the order.
10. Petitioner requested an Exception to a previous Board Order dated June 13, 2017, requesting an unencumbered license. It was the Committee's decision to **deny** the request.
11. Petitioner requested an Exception to a previous Board Order dated May 12, 2009, requesting an unencumbered license. It was the Committee's decision to **deny** the request.
12. Petitioner requested an Exception to a previous Board Order dated September 13, 2016, requesting the supervision requirement be modified and he be allowed access to controlled substances. It was the Committee's decision to **grant** the requests.
13. Petitioner requested an Exception to a previous Board Order dated June 14, 2017, requesting an unencumbered license or reduction in the length of the order. It was the Committee's decision to **deny** the requests.

Motions for Rehearing

No motions for rehearing were considered by the Committee.

Orders Ratified:

Sixty-three (63) disciplinary agreed orders were approved.

Thirteen (13) reinstatement agreed orders were approved.

Thirteen (13) eligibility agreed orders were approved.

Thirty-eight (38) default revocation orders were approved.

Five (5) deferred disciplinary action agreed order was approved.

Two (2) KSTAR Pilot Program agreed orders were approved.
