

**Appointment of Replacement Member to Advisory Committee on Licensure,
Eligibility and Discipline**

Background: Board rule 211.6(f) creates standing advisory committees to advise the Board on a continuous basis or as charged by the Board. The Advisory Committee on Licensure, Eligibility and Discipline (Committee) is one of the Board's standing advisory committees, and is comprised of representatives from several organizations, including the Texas Association of Vocational Nurse Educators (TAVNE). See §211.6(f)(1)(D).

Board Staff was informed in November 2019 that Dr. Lacey Bass, TAVNE's current representative on the Committee, resigned her position with TAVNE. A replacement member is therefore needed to represent TAVNE on the Committee.
