

Rule Review of 22 Texas Administrative Code 225 (relating to RN Delegation to Unlicensed Personnel and Tasks Not Requiring Delegation in Independent Living Environments for Clients with Stable and Predictable Conditions)

As required by Texas Government Code §2001.039, Staff began the process to file the Board's notice of intention to review and consider for re-adoption, re-adoption with amendments, or repeal, Chapter 225 contained in Title 22, Part 11, of the Texas Administrative Code, with the *Texas Register*, pursuant to the 2019 rule review plan adopted by the Board at its July 2018 meeting.

As part of the review, the reasons for originally adopting this chapter will be assessed to determine if they still exist. Further, each section of the chapter will be reviewed to determine whether it is obsolete, whether it reflects current legal and policy considerations and current procedures and practices of the Board, and whether it is in compliance with Chapter 2001 of the Government Code (Administrative Procedure Act). The public will have thirty (30) days from the publication of the rule review in the *Texas Register* to comment and submit any response or suggestions. If no negative comments and no request for a public hearing are received, Chapter 225 will be re-adopted without amendment.
