

Promoting Competency Report

The Texas Board of Nursing's educational offerings and Continuing Nursing Education (CNE) courses provide nurses with an opportunity to increase their knowledge of the laws, rules and regulations that affect their nursing practice and contribute to their continuing competency. These offerings and CNE courses are a high priority for Board staff and support the Board's mission of patient safety.

Attachment A to this report reflects attendance for educational offerings, CNE or stipulations, for the third quarter of FY 2022. Specifically, Attachments A reflects the number of registrants who completed the:

Attachment B reflects Continuing Competency Offerings currently offered for the 2022 calendar year, including workshop dates. Board members are welcome to attend workshops and enroll in any of the course offerings free of charge.

The final workshop scheduled for 2022 will be in November, and this workshop will be virtual. This format continues to be extremely popular with the attendees. Board staff have obtained approval for the November workshop to offer 8.7 contact hours instead of 7.7. The additional time will permit presenters to include more content and interactive audience polling. In June the practice team changed the workshop webinar platform from Webex to Microsoft Teams and the workshop has been more user friendly than ever before. Next year the practice team will continue virtual workshops and add one in person workshop in Austin. Additional goals for the future include, updating existing online enduring courses in the Board's course catalog and developing new course offerings. Enduring online offerings are intended to provide easier access, in a more cost-effective way, so that nurses can obtain information on specific aspects of the NPA and Board rules applicable to their current area of practice. The Educational Offerings Director (EOD) will conduct the next annual CNE Needs Assessment & Planning Meeting in January 2023 and will provide a report to the Board in April 2023.
