

Promoting Competency Report

The Texas Board of Nursing's educational offerings and Continuing Nursing Education (CNE) courses provide nurses with an opportunity to increase their knowledge of the laws, rules and regulations that affect their nursing practice and contribute to their continuing competency. These offerings and CNE courses are a high priority for Board staff and support the Board's mission of patient safety.

Five workshops are scheduled for 2023. In June the practice team will hold the first in person workshop since 2020 at the JJ Pickle Research Center in Austin. All other workshops will be virtual, this format continues to be extremely popular with the attendees. The Educational Offerings Director (EOD) will conduct the next annual CNE Needs Assessment & Planning Meeting in January 2023. Participants in the meeting will identify goals for continuing education offering development for the next calendar year. The EOD will provide a report to the Board in April 2023.
