The mission of the Texas Board of Nursing is to protect and promote the welfare of the people of Texas by ensuring that each person holding a license as a nurse in the State of Texas is competent to practice safely. The Board fulfills its mission through the regulation of the practice of nursing and the approval of nursing education programs. This mission, derived from the Nursing Practice Act, supersedes the interest of any individual, the nursing profession, or any special interest group.

APRNs to be Issued a License Number

The Texas Board of Nursing will begin issuing separate license numbers to all advanced practice registered nurses (APRNs) beginning this fall to implement SB 406 and the Consensus Model for APRN Regulation: Licensure, Accreditation, Certification, and Education. APRNs will continue to hold a separate registered nurse (RN) license number in addition to the new APRN license number. Those APRNs who have prescriptive authority will continue to have the same prescriptive authority identification numbers and will continue to use these same numbers when authorizing or issuing prescriptions.

Employers and other interested parties will be able to verify APRN licensure status using either the soon to be issued APRN license number or a Texas RN license number. Please note: those APRNs who have been licensed to practice using two or more advanced practice titles will be issued a single APRN license number that includes authority to practice in all advanced practice roles and population foci for which the APRN has been licensed. It will be the responsibility of each APRN to provide his/her new APRN license number to employers, third party payers, and other appropriate entities.

Notification will be placed on our website at www.bon.texas.gov when the numbers are issued.

Senate Bill 406 Brings Change for Advanced Practice Registered Nurses

During the 83rd Legislative Session (regular session), Senate Bill (SB) 406 by Senator Jane Nelson was passed in order to improve the process for physician delegation of prescriptive authority to advanced practice registered nurses (APRNs) and physician assistants (PA). The new law will clarify that prescriptive authority is required for ordering and prescribing medications and devices, including durable medical equipment. APRNs and physicians in most practice settings will develop a prescriptive authority agreement that will serve as the mechanism for delegation. APRNs in facility-based practices may continue to use Protocols or other written authorization to provide medical aspects of care; however, other site-based prescriptive authority requirements for alternate and primary practice sites will be eliminated from the law. In practice settings other than hospital facility-based practices and practices serving medically underserved populations, the physician may delegate to seven APRNs or PAs or their full time equivalents.

With regard to ordering and prescribing controlled substances, limited authority to prescribe Schedule II medications was included. Physicians may delegate the authority to order or prescribe Schedule II medications in hospice and in hospitals. Those APRNs who practice in hospital practices may only order or prescribe Schedule II medications for patients who are seen in the emergency department or inpatients who are intended to have a stay of at least 24 hours.

Nurse anesthetists may continue to practice under the current provisions of the law and will not be required to obtain prescriptive authority. They must continue to practice in accordance with facility policy or medical staff bylaws and have an order to administer anesthesia or provide an anesthesia-related service.

We want to remind all APRNs that **this new law does not become effective until November 1, 2013**. Until November 1, APRNs must continue to practice under the current site-based prescriptive authority regulations. Likewise, APRNs may not order or prescribe controlled substances in

Schedule II until November 1 and until they have been properly authorized to do so by the Texas Department of Public Safety (DPS) and the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA).

SB 406 also granted the Board the authority to issue licenses to APRNs. Staff members are working to develop a process whereby APRN license numbers will be issued to all APRNs with *current* Texas licensure. As information regarding the issuance of licenses becomes available, we will update our website (www.bon.texas.gov). Please be sure to check the Advanced Practice page frequently. We are also working on revisions to Board Rules 221 and 222 as a result of passage SB 406. Be sure to review the summary of the board meeting in each newsletter and also visit our website frequently to stay up to date with the progress of these revisions.

Summary of Actions



A regular meeting of the Board of Nursing was held July 18-19, 2013, in Austin. The following is a summary of Board actions taken during this meeting.

On August 9, 2013, the Board proposed amendments to 22 Tex. Admin. Code (TAC) sections 214.3 [relating to licensed vocational nurse Program Development, Expansion and Closure]; 215.3 [relating to professional nurse Program Development, Expansion and Closure]; 223.1 (relating to Fees), and the repeal of Chapter 222 [relating to Advanced Practice Registered Nurses (APRNs) with Prescriptive Authority] and new Chapter 222 concerning APRNs with prescriptive authority. The amendment to 22 TAC 214.3 establishes, in rule, a \$500 filing fee for an out-of-state vocational nursing education program seeking to conduct clinical learning experiences in Texas; and clarifies that the Board may withdraw the approval of any out-of-state vocational nursing education program that fails to maintain the requirements necessary for initial approval to conduct clinical learning experiences in Texas. The amendments to §215.3 establish, in rule, a \$500 filing fee for an out-of-state professional nursing education program seeking to conduct clinical learning experiences in Texas; and clarifies that the Board may withdraw the approval of any out-of-state professional nursing education pro-

gram that fails to maintain the requirements necessary for initial approval to conduct clinical learning experiences in Texas. Proposed new Chapter 222, §§222.1 -222.10, concerning Advanced Practice Registered Nurses with Prescriptive Authority is necessary to implement Senate Bill (SB) 406, which was enacted by the 83rd Texas Legislature, Regular Session, effective November 1, 2013. The proposed amendments to §223.1, relating to Fees, are necessary to: establish, in rule, a \$500 filing fee for an out-of-state nursing education program seeking to conduct clinical learning experiences in Texas; and reduce the licensure renewal fee for registered nurses (RN) from \$73 to \$70.

On August 16, 2013, the Board proposed amendments to 22 TAC sections 211.7 (relating to the Executive Director), 213.3 (relating to Pleading), and 216.3 (relating to Requirements). The amendments to 22 TAC 211.7 authorize the Board's Executive Director to approve and accept certain Board Orders on behalf of the Board, without Board ratification. The amendments to 22 TAC 213.3 are necessary to: implement the provisions of Senate Bill (SB) 1058, which was enacted by the 83rd Texas Legislature, Regular Session, effective

September 1, 2013 and clarify the Board's existing procedural requirements relating to licensure and eligibility matters. The amendment to 22 TAC 216.3 requires APRNs who prescribe controlled substances to complete an additional 3 hours of continuing education related to prescribing controlled substances each biennium. The proposed amendment to 216.3 is necessary for consistency with the requirements of proposed new Chapter 222, relating to Advanced Practice Registered Nurses with Prescriptive Authority, published in the Texas Register on August 9, 2013.

The Board held a public hearing on Friday, September 13, 2013, to receive public comments on proposed new Chapter 222, relating to Advanced Practice Registered Nurses with Prescriptive Authority, as published in the *Texas Register* on August 9, 2013. The Board will consider comments concerning proposed new Chapter 222, as well as proposed amendments to section 216.3, at the regularly scheduled meeting of the Board on October 17-18, 2013.

Amended 22 TAC §§214.3, 215.3, and 223.1 will become effective October 1, 2013.

Checklists in Healthcare

Poor communication frequently results in adverse outcomes for patients. Nurses use checklists every day as tools to enhance communication between members of the healthcare team and to improve patient care delivery. Nurses have developed many types of checklists to remind the healthcare team of essential information that should be evaluated. For example, the assessment and documentation of vital signs are two of the most important functions that nurses perform. In the 1960s, nurses were credited with the development of a checklist that captured patients' vital signs. The vital signs checklist serves as a reminder for when to assess vital signs as well as a place to document these data points; thus communicating to healthcare providers an overall snapshot of the health and well-being of patients.



Background

The use of checklists began in the aeronautical industry in 1935. Following a terrible plane crash in the U.S. Army Air Corps that killed two of the five crew members, including a senior experienced pilot, the investigation did not reveal any mechanical issues. The crash was attributed to pilot error. The new aircraft being demonstrated was felt to be more complex than previous aircraft and required the pilot to focus on many things at once. Following this crash, test pilots came together and decided that the aircraft was so complex to operate that they could not rely on memory alone and decided to develop a checklist. Gawande (2009) stated, "Pilots learn in flight school that memory and judgment are unreliable and that lives depend on their recognizing that fact" (p.121). Parallels can be drawn to nursing. Nurses must focus on many complex aspects of patient care simultaneously and memory alone may be inadequate.

Much is written about the use of checklists in healthcare literature. In 2001, Dr. Peter Pronovost, a critical

care specialist at John Hopkins Hospital, developed a checklist for the insertion of central lines as a tool to help decrease central line infections. A year after the implementation of this checklist, central line infection rates dropped from 11% to 0%. Not believing the data, he followed patients for 15 more months and only two central line infections occurred. Gawande (2009) discusses how Dr. Pronovost calculated that the use of the checklist "had prevented forty-three infections and eight deaths and saved two million dollars in costs" (p. 39) in one hospital alone. Dr.

Pronovost and his healthcare team became believers in checklists. His team then developed more checklists and Gawande (2009) noted that they "improved the consistency of care to the point that the average length of patient stay in intensive care dropped by half" (p. 39). In 2003, the Michigan Health and Hospital Association asked Dr. Pronovost to test the use of central line checklists in their hospitals and in 2006 they published the findings in the *New England Journal of Medicine*. Gawande (2009) noted that "central line infection rates in Michigan's ICUs decreased by 66% and the hospitals' estimated savings were \$175 million in costs and more than 1500 lives" (p. 44).

In 2006, the World Health Organization (WHO) began its work on the surgical checklist used in operating rooms today. The WHO realized that the number of surgical cases was exploding with 230 million cases being performed annually, leaving seven million people a year disabled and at least one million dead. Enlisting the help of Dr. Atul Gawande, a patient safety advocate, a general and endocrine surgeon at the Brigham and Women's Hospital in Boston and associate professor at Harvard Medical School, the WHO began its work. Two years into the project, Gawande (2009) noted the results of their efforts demonstrated



that the "rate of major complications for surgical patients in all eight hospitals fell by 36 percent after introduction of the checklist. Deaths fell 47 percent" (p. 154). Infections decreased by almost half. Checklists seemed to work.

Current Use

The use of checklists in health care is growing and results are promising. Shinkman (2010) references a study in which "a single major surgical complication costs \$13,372, more than the cost of implementing a checklist and the use of a checklist could reduce complication rates by ~10% for a net cost reduction of \$8,652 for every complication that is avoided" (para 4). Arriaga et al. (2013) reported that in a simulation based study of operating room crisis, teams missed only 6% of potentially life-saving processes of care when checklists were available compared with 23% of steps missed when there were not checklists immediately on hand.

Nurse managers may find that a checklist is helpful with multiple everyday responsibilities. Nurse managers are in the unique position of being responsible to administration as well as to patients and staff with patient safety being a number one priority for all. Govero (2012) suggests that managers may find it useful

to develop a tool that addresses the myriad of responsibilities that includes employee satisfaction and engagement, patient satisfaction, performance improvement, and productivity.

Summary

Checklists, while promising, are not without limitations. Every patient safety issue cannot be solved with a checklist; however, the use of checklists in healthcare has proven successful in preventing many errors as well as generating monetary savings. Checklists may be one tool essential to nursing practice to foster communication, collaboration and teamwork to improve patient care delivery.

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Heparin Label Alert and CDC Health Advisory related to Synthetic Opioid Overdose

There are many ways nurses can receive information to inform their nursing practice including a quarterly bulletin from the Board of Nursing, information from professional associations, information and alerts issued by various patient safety organizations and information from employers. One of the swiftest methods of information distribution is electronic communication. Two alerts were released in June 2013.

The National Coordinating Council for Medication Error Reporting and Prevention (NCC MERP) issued an alert related to Heparin labeling. Heparin has been identified by many patient safety organizations as a high alert medication that is prone to errors that reach patients. There have been numerous patient safety issues related to Heparin over the years. The alert in June 2013 related to Heparin labeling was sent by the National Alert Network, and was available on websites such as the Institute for Safe Medication Practices (www.ismp.org) and the American Nurses Association (www.nursingworld.org).

Nurses can advocate for patient safety by critically thinking through the medication administration process to anticipate risks inherent to the medication being administered, patient risk factors such as age, allergies, impaired ability to metabolize certain medications, the system where medications are being administered and identification of other risk factors. By having access to alerts, newsletters, or other information related to patient safety, a nurse can increase situational awareness of patient safety issues. Please remember the rights of medication administration when administering any medication and check medication labels carefully.

The Centers for Disease Control (CDC) also released a health advisory related to patients presenting with synthetic opioid overdose. In June and July a number of news organizations reported on opioid overdoses and deaths through multimedia venues. The CDC alert provided specific guidance in relation to suggested tests and treatments for patients suspected of having a synthetic opioid overdose. The alert was issued through the Health Alert Network provided by the CDC and links were available through various organizations. There is a link on the CDC website to sign up for alerts (www.cdc.gov).

Nurses play a vital role in providing measures to stabilize patients [Board Rule 217.11(1)(M)]. A nurse who stays informed of trends, issues, alerts and other information relevant to the nurse's area of practice can bring current, up-to-date knowledge to patient care delivery. Information sources such as the Board of Nursing website (www.bon.texas.gov), professional nursing associations, and national patient safety organizations, especially those related to a nurse's area of practice could be considered and utilized to bring about better informed nursing practice and enhanced patient safety.

TONI STRINGFELLOW a.k.a. Toni C. Stringfellow

Toni Stringfellow has an extensive history with the Board regarding her illegal practice as a professional nurse, including several convictions. The Board received its first case regarding Toni Stringfellow on February 9, 1989. Since that time, the Board has received numerous other complaints.

Most recently, after being released from prison, Toni Stringfellow secured employment as Director of Nursing with a long term care facility in San Antonio, Texas, on May 14, 2013. She used the name and license information belonging to a currently licensed RN. On June 6, 2013, a resident made a police report regarding her Macy's credit card that was stolen. The campus police conducted an investigation and discovered that the resident's personal information was used in an attempt to open another account and was mailed to an address belonging to Toni Stringfellow. On June 7, 2013, Ms. Stringfellow was arrested and she later submitted a letter of resignation to the facility. The case was referred to the San Antonio Police Department.



FERTINA BROWN

On May 7, 2013, Fertina Brown was indicted on one count of MAKING A FALSE DOCUMENT. Ms. Brown Forged a license to work as a nurse with the United States Postal Service. In 2007, Ms. Brown submitted an application for a position as a registered nurse to the United States Postal Service (USPS) where she was employed as a mail carrier and presented a copy of a TX License. Ms. Brown used the TX RN License belonging to a nurse who resided in Texas and was on active duty. In January 2011, when that license expired the USPS requested a current license. On February 2, 2011, Fertina Brown presented the USPS a license from the State of Georgia, which turned out to be forged. On July 9, 2013, Fertina Brown plead guilty in the United States District Court, Northern District of Georgia.



Legislative Summary: 83rd Texas Legislative Session



The following is a summary of some of the bills impacting the practice of nursing in Texas. For the full text of the bills included in this summary, visit www.capitol.state.tx.us.

Bills amending Nursing Practice Act

Senate Bill (SB) 1058 by Jane Nelson. Adds new continuing education requirements related to nursing jurisprudence and ethics, as well as continuing education related to older adults or geriatric populations for nurses working in a practice area related to geriatric populations.

SB 1058 also makes criminal background checks mandatory for students accepted for enrollment in a nursing education program and permits the Board of Nursing (BON or Board) to initiate declaratory orders for eligibility proceedings based on positive criminal background checks; makes permanent the Board's current pilot authority to impose deferred disciplinary action; clarifies that action may be taken against a nurse's license based on action taken by a division of the United States Military; authorizes the BON, in conjunction with a disciplinary action, to require a nurse to abstain from use of alcohol and drugs and submit to random drug testing; provides for limited non-disclosure of disciplinary proceedings that result in a Board order requiring the nurse to participate in a Board-approved peer assistance program to address a problem that the nurse is experiencing with mental illness or chemical dependency; as well as making other changes relating to disciplinary action taken by the Board.

The Nursing Practice Advisory Committee (NPAC) met on September 18, 2013 to draft proposed changes to agency rules necessary to implement SB 1058. The Board will consider NPAC's recommendations at the October 2013 Board Meeting.

SB 406 by Jane Nelson. Eliminates the requirement for on-site physician supervision and increases the number of Advanced Practice Registered Nurses a physician can supervise from four to seven. Additionally, it allows physicians to delegate authority to prescribe Schedule II controlled substances in hospitals and hospice settings. The bill requires periodic face-to-face meetings

between APRNs and the delegating physician. See article on page one for further information.

SB 743 by Jane Nelson. Requires the BON to suspend a nurse's license or refuse to issue a license to an applicant on proof that the nurse or applicant has been initially convicted of an offense involving a violation of certain court orders or conditions of bond under Section 25.07, 25.071, or 25.072, Penal Code, punished as a felony, or other offenses.

House Bill (HB) 581 by Donna Howard. Authorizes a nurse employed by a hospital operated by or on behalf of a state or local entity to sue the governmental entity to recover limited damages for certain retaliatory actions taken against the nurse for fulfilling obligations as a licensed nurse practicing under Texas law; and specifies that sovereign immunity of the state or local governmental entity from suit and from liability is waived for the limited purpose of allowing the nurse to maintain a lawsuit in state court to obtain such relief.

Other Bills Relating to Nursing Practice

HB 705 by Donna Howard. Enhances penalty prescribed for an assault committed against emergency services personnel.

HB 1803 by Bill Callegari. APRNs who practice in pain management settings need to be aware that they may not own or operate pain management clinics.

HB 1846 by Stefani Carter. The Texas BON will check for delinquent child support payments and reject applications for nurses not in compliance.

HB 2099 by Ryan Guillen. Allows representatives from career colleges and private universities with nursing programs to participate on statutorily created higher education regional councils. Amends the Education Code to include admissions and available

scholarships to nursing students as part of a common application used by all state nursing programs.

SB 34 by Judith Zaffirini. Addresses requirements for consent for the administration of psychoactive medications.

SB 62 by Jane Nelson. Allows students 22 years and older the ability to show an exemption from the bacterial meningitis vaccine.

SB 152 by Jane Nelson. Requires the BON to report back to the Department of Family and Protective Services when a nurse may have abused or neglected an adult or child.

SB 939 by Royce West. Nurses working in school districts, charter schools, child care facilities and institutions of higher learning will need to know new requirements for policy development related to child sexual abuse and maltreatment.

SB 945 by Jane Nelson. Nurses working, contracting, training or in an educational program in a hospital must wear a photo identification badge. The badge must include first OR last name, the department the nurse works in, type of license held and if applicable: student, faculty or trainee.

SB 1191 by Wendy Davis. Prohibits a person from performing a forensic examination on sexual assault patient unless the person has the basic sexual assault forensic evidence collection training.

SB 1643 by Tommy Williams. Allows a nurse acting at the direction of a provider to access the prescription monitoring program to inquire regarding a patient's recent prescription history for scheduled medications.

SB 1842 by Bob Deuell. In hospitals and state mental hospitals, patients will have a face to face assessment within one hour after initiation of a restraint or seclusion by a RN who has special training and did not initiate the restraint or seclusion.
