Board Seeks Reduced Fees for Nurse License Renewals

In the November 21, 2014, issue of the *Texas Register*, the Texas Board of Nursing proposed changes to §223.1 seeking a reduction in nurse license renewal fees (also see *Summary of Actions* on page 3). The proposed fee reduction is based on projected increased agency revenue for Fiscal Year 2015. For the 2014-2015 biennium, the Texas Board of Nursing is required by the General Appropriations Act (through a contingency revenue rider) to generate fees totaling \$25,334,204. In July 2013, the Board voted to revise its fees in order to raise this additional money. Based on a review of past renewal trends, staff expect the number of renewals for fiscal year 2015 to increase by three percent. Provided this projection holds true at the current fee structure, staff projected that the Board would exceed the amount of monies required by the contingency revenue rider by approximately \$4,000,000. As a result, staff recommended that the Board amend its fees to reduce the anticipated amount of surplus.

Staff recommended that the Board reduce each licensure renewal fee by \$10, reducing the renewal fee for an advanced practice registered nursing license to \$50.00; \$60.00 for a registered nurse license renewal; and \$45.00 for renewal of a vocational nursing license. If no comments are received to the proposed fee changes, the earliest effective date for the reduced license renewal fees is December 21, 2014.

Neissa Brown Springmann appointed to replace Shelby Ellzey

On October 10, 2014, Governor Rick Perry appointed Neissa Brown Springmann of Austin to the Texas Board of Nursing as consumer member. Ms. Springmann replaces Shelby Ellzey, who resigned from the Board, and will serve the remainder of Ms. Ellzey's term that expires on January 31, 2015. Ms. Springmann is founder and CEO of a health and wellness program for women in Austin.

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NDA 1-8 Notice of Disciplinary Action

Deborah Bell Elected Vice-President of BON

At the regular meeting of the Texas Board of Nursing (BON) held October 23-24, 2014, Deborah Bell, CLU, ChFC, RIA, was elected Vice-President of the BON. Ms. Bell was first appointed to the Board of Nurse Examiners in July, 2001. She was then appointed to serve on the new 13-member board that combined the Board of Nurse Examiners and the Board of Vocational Nurse Examiners in 2004. Ms. Bell was reappointed to the Board on February 17, 2005 and again on April 17, 2011. Ms. Bell served as Vice-President of the Board in 2009. Ms. Bell is Vice-President of Compass Financial Strategies and serves as a board member of the Abilene Regional Medical Center, past Vice-President of the Abilene Chamber of Commerce, past member of the Society of Financial Service Professionals, and previous board member of the Brazos River Authority. Ms. Bell also serves on the Finance Committee for the National Council of State Boards of Nursing. Ms. Bell's term on the BON expires on January 31, 2017.



Advisory Committee Updates

Delegation Task Force Completes Charge

In July 2011, the Board charged staff to develop a Delegation Task Force to review and make recommendations to Chapter 224 and 225 on RN Delegation. Amendments to Chapter 225 recently became effective in February 2014. On September 4, 2014, the Delegation Task Force for Chapter 224 completed its charge. Board staff presented the Task Force's recommendations for consideration to the Board during the October 2014 Board Meeting. The Board approved the proposed amendments to 22 Tex. Admin Code §224, *Delegation of Nursing Tasks by Registered Professional Nurses to Unlicensed Personnel for Clients with Acute Conditions or in Acute Care Environments*. The proposed amendments will be published in the *Texas Register*. If no negative comments and no requests for a public hearing are received, the Board may move to adopt the proposed amendments during the January 2015 Board Meeting. Board staff is grateful to the members of both Task Forces for their commitment to improving the delegation rules.

Task Force to Study Implications of Growth of Nursing Education Programs in Texas

At the October 2014 Meeting, the Board accepted the report from the Task Force to Study Implications of Growth of Nursing Education Programs in Texas including the Monograph and the Education Guideline 3.8.7.a. Faculty Guide to Promoting Optimal Clinical Instruction, and charged the Task Force to:

- Disseminate the information to nursing education programs and clinical partners through the website, webinars, publications, and a statewide nursing faculty workshop; and
- Create a dialogue between nursing education and clinical partners to facilitate optimal clinical learning experiences for all constituents.

Summary of Actions

A regular meeting of the Board of Nursing was held October 23-24, 2014, in Austin. The following is a summary of Board actions taken during this meeting.



In the November 21, 2014, issue of the *Texas Register*, the Texas Board of Nursing proposed amendments to §223.1, concerning *Fees*. The amendments are proposed under the authority of the Occupations Code §301.151 and §301.155 and are necessary to comply with budgetary require-

ments established by the Texas Legislature. The proposed amendments will reduce each current level of licensure renewal by \$10, thereby making the new renewal fee for a vocational nurse license \$45; the renewal fee for a registered nurse license \$60; and the renewal fee for an advanced

practice registered nurse license \$50. The proposed amendments may be accessed at: www.sos.state.tx.us/texreg/pdf/backview/1121/1121prop.pdf with the earliest date of adoption: December 21, 2014.

KSTAR Pilot Program for Nurses Launched



Most nurses never intend to make a mistake or commit an error. When a practice breakdown occurs, a nurse's skill and abilities are questioned and the Texas Board of Nursing may take disciplinary action for a violation of the Nursing Practice Act. The Board holds the public trust and its mission, in part, is to ensure those who violate the Nursing Practice Act are competent and meet the minimum standards of nursing practice in order to retain licensure. Most of the Board's disciplinary actions based on practice breakdowns involve some form of remediation and may require a subsequent period of monitored practice of the nurse. The Board is continually seeking to improve the methods used to remediate a nurse's practice after a practice breakdown and is interested in exploring disciplinary options that are less punitive and consistent with the Just Culture concepts of correcting the nurse's specific knowledge deficits that resulted in the practice breakdown. Improving the quality of how a nurse is remediated may reassure the public that nurses with disciplinary actions have received education and demonstrated competency relevant to the specific, individualized areas needing remediation.

In October 2013, consistent with the Board's authority under the Nursing Practice Act Sections 301.453(b) and 301.1605(a), the Board approved an innovative two-year pilot program called **Knowledge, Skills, Training, Assessment and Research (KSTAR)** for Nurses and in July 2014, adopted Board Rule 213.35. An alternate form of discipline, KSTAR Pilot Program is designed to assess a nurse's competency and provide remediation specific to the compe-

tency issue involved in the practice breakdown. Once a competency assessment is completed, if any knowledge deficits are determined, an individualized remediation plan is developed that may include a period of monitoring and follow-up. The Board has approved the Texas A & M Health Sciences Center (HSC) College of Nursing (CON) and the Rural and Community Health Institute to implement the KSTAR Pilot Program for nurses which is patterned after the successful KSTAR for physicians program.

Licensed vocational nurses (LVNs) and registered nurses (RNs) found to have engaged in a practice breakdown that would justify a disciplinary action at a level of Warning, a Warning with Stipulations, a Warning with Stipulations and a Fine, a Warning with a Fine, Remedial Education, Remedial Education with a Fine, or a Fine (based on the Board's Disciplinary Matrix) may be eligible for an agreed order to participate in the KSTAR Pilot Program for nurses. For example, rather than the traditional Warning with Stipulations which often requires a period of employer based monitoring, the agreed order would be a Warning with the stipulation that the nurse successfully complete KSTAR Pilot Program for nurses. It is hoped that successful completion of a KSTAR Pilot Program order will avoid the need for an employer based monitoring period.

Disciplinary actions that result in the sanction level of revocation, reprimand or suspension will not be eligible for the pilot. In addition, violations involving sexual misconduct, criminal conduct, intentional acts, falsification, deception, chemical dependency, or substance abuse will not be eligible for resolution

through the pilot. Additionally, remedial education in nursing jurisprudence and ethics will be a requirement of the pilot.

As in the traditional remedial education process, each nurse will be responsible for their own costs associated with participation in the pilot program, including travel to the Texas A & M HSC CON, Round Rock campus where the KSTAR for nurses pilot program is housed. The cost will include assessments, testing, teaching materials, resources and a report to the Board upon completion of the pilot. The report will inform the Board as to whether the nurse successfully completed the pilot program, thus verifying a minimum level of competency, or will make recommendations for further action by the Board.

Nurses who fail to complete the KSTAR Pilot Program for nurses will be reported back to the Board by Texas A & M HSC CON and the Rural and Community Health Institute for traditional or additional disciplinary action. Like traditional agreed orders, the KSTAR Pilot Program agreed orders would be public orders, become a part of the nurse's permanent record and be reported to the National Practitioner Data Bank. Because of the nature of KSTAR's individualized assessment, education and demonstration of competency, the program may also provide an opportunity in the future to reeducate those individuals seeking to reenter nursing practice after an extended absence. This reeducation may assure the Board a nurse has demonstrated minimum competency before relicensure.

Update on Texas Taxonomy of Error Root Cause Analysis of Practice-responsibility (TERCAP) Pilot

The Texas Board of Nursing (Board) would like to acknowledge the peer review committees who voluntarily participated in the TERCAP Pilot. The Board would also like to provide an overview of the first two years of data collection.

In 2011, the 82nd Legislature passed Senate Bill 193 allowing the Board to adopt a standardized error classification system for utilization by Texas nursing peer review committees. Consequently, the Board implemented a pilot with selected peer review committees from hospitals around the state. The pilot allowed representatives from participating sites to enter nursing practice breakdown incidents into the TERCAP state-wide online data base. The practice breakdown incidents appropriate for the pilot included cases that a nursing peer review committee had reviewed and determined were not required to be reported to the Board (see 22 *Texas Administrative Code Rule 217.16, Reporting of Minor Incidents*).

The pilot program's online data base became functional on September 1, 2012. The online data base collects confidential error events that have been reported to a nursing peer review committee and deemed not reportable to the Board. Submission of the practice breakdown cases in the Texas TERCAP Pilot Program is voluntary and confidential.

The data from the first two years of the pilot were analyzed and presented to the Board at the October 2014 Board meeting (the entire report may be found online - see agenda item 5.3.3.a). The analysis consisted of 191 usable events. The two most frequently reported categories of system factors that

contributed to practice breakdown were communication system factors and health care team factors. Approximately half of the events included a documentation error with the most frequent type of documentation error being incomplete or lack of charting.

Over the next two years, the continued pilot data collection will provide the ability for a more comprehensive and extensive analysis of data. The results of the data analysis may shape future direction and support for incorporating the model into Board policy.

Texas TERCAP Pilot Implications for Acute Care Organizations:

- **Ensure a stable, fully functional nursing peer review committee (NPRC) and chair are in place**
- **Provide adequate training to NPRC members related to evaluation of nursing practice breakdown and Board of Nursing reporting requirements**
- **Ensure that policies are in place for RN evaluation of all nursing practice breakdown events reported to Risk Management or Patient Safety Committees to ascertain if a referral to the NPRC is needed**

Not all nursing practice breakdown involved documentation errors; however, in 35% of the cases with documentation errors, the documentation led to the nursing practice breakdown. Among the types of nursing practice breakdown categories evaluated, clinical reasoning ranked as the most frequently selected practice breakdown category. The importance of clinical reasoning and its impact on nursing practice is an area replete with investigative opportunities.

Does your certification meet BON requirements for licensure renewal?

Nursing certification is one method that nurses may utilize to meet the continuing competency requirements for licensure renewal. There are many different certifications available, but not all certifications are accepted by the Board of Nursing (BON) to meet licensure renewal requirements. An approved national nursing certification in the nurse's area of practice that is achieved, maintained or renewed within a licensure cycle may be used to meet the continuing competency requirements of licensure renewal [Board Rule 216.3(b)].

The Board has approved four specific national nursing certifications and all certifications approved by the Accreditation Board for Specialty Nursing Certification (ABSNC). The specific certifications approved by the Board to meet continuing competency requirements are the Pharmacology and Long-Term Care certifications offered by the National Association for Practical Nurse Education & Service, Inc. (NAPNES) for LVNs and the certifications for LVNs and RNs through the Developmental Disabilities Nurses Association. The ABSNC website has a complete listing of the organization offering the certification and specifically approved certifications (see the listing at: www.nursingcertification.org/accreditation-exams.html).

Several examples included on the ABSNC website include the CWOCN®, CWCN®, COCN®, CCCN®, or CWON® certifications offered by the Wound, Ostomy, Continence Nursing Certification Board and the OCN®,

CPON®, and CBCN® offered by the Oncology Nursing Certification Corporation. The CNOR® certification, through the Competency & Credentialing Institute is approved by ABSNC and is the certification required for the registered nurse first assistant (RNFA) [Board Rule 217.18 (a)(C)(i)]. The American Nurses Credentialing Center has a large number of certifications that are approved by ABSNC that are also listed.

The advanced practice registered nurse (APRN) may use the national certification the Board recognizes for licensure in the role and population focus area to meet the continuing competency licensure renewal requirements. The certifications for the various APRN titles are available on the Board website (www.bon.texas.gov/pdfs/aprn_pdfs/APRN-Certification-Exams.pdf). The APRN with prescriptive authority will also need to complete five additional contact hours of continuing education in pharmacotherapeutics [Board Rule 216.3 (c)].

A **new** requirement for APRNs who prescribe controlled substances: for every licensure cycle after January 1, 2015, the APRN who orders or prescribes controlled substances will need to complete three additional contact hours of continuing education related to prescribing controlled substances [Board Rule 216.3 (c)]. The nursing certification does not fulfill these mandatory continuing education requirements.

Please be aware that an approved national nursing certification does not meet the requirements for all nurses to complete at least two continuing nursing education hours in nursing jurisprudence and nursing ethics prior to the end of every third two year licensure renewal cycle [Board Rule 216.3 (g)]. Nursys e-Notify, the national nurse licensure notification system that automatically delivers licensure and publicly available discipline data directly to employers as the data is entered into the Nursys database by U.S. boards of nursing (BONs), is now offered at no cost to employers and individual nurses.

Nursys, which was launched by the National Council of State Boards of Nursing in 2013, is the only national database for verification of nurse licensure, discipline, and practice privileges for registered nurses and licensed practical/vocational nurses. It is comprised of data obtained directly from the licensure systems of U.S. BONs through frequent, secured updates.

If a nurse's license is about to expire, licensees and employers have the option to receive a notification about the expiration date. Employers can also immediately learn about new disciplinary actions issued by a BON for their employed nurse, including receiving access to available public discipline documents. Nursys e-Notify eliminates the need for employers to proactively search for nurse data because they are notified when changes occur.

Texas Peer Assistance Program for Nurses: Expanded Assistive Services

The Texas Peer Assistance Program for Nurses (TPAPN) has been providing assistance to nurses for substance use disorders (SUD) and certain psychiatric disorders since 1987. The ability for some nurses to participate in TPAPN with confidential Board orders began in September 2013. In general, TPAPN offers the nurse, employers of nurses, and the public a safety net that attempts to screen for risk and provide nurses an opportunity to demonstrate accountability for safe nursing practice and good recovery.

In collaboration with the Board of Nursing (BON), TPAPN over time has expanded its assistance services to more comprehensively address the possible signs of substance abuse through the Extended Evaluation Program (EEP). Also, the Mental Health Support Program (MHSP) was established

for nurses identified as having certain psychiatric diagnoses.

EEP was first implemented in 2007 while MHSP just got underway in the latter part of 2014. MHSP provides nurses the means to obtain documented support that demonstrates a year of recovery when nurses affirm they have one of the psychiatric diagnoses included in the TPAPN program.

TPAPN's soon to be launched Interim Monitoring track allows nurses, who would otherwise have been dismissed from TPAPN, to have the means to continue supportive monitoring, including possible practice restrictions and random drug testing. Without this option, nurses would not have formal support or monitoring after dismissal from TPAPN while awaiting possible licensure action by the BON.

How to Register

To register for a Texas Board of Nursing (BON or Board) Workshop or Webinar, please visit our website at www.bon.texas.gov and click on **Education** and then **Continuing Nursing Education & Competency**. You will register for all BON educational offerings: the online continuing education course, workshops and webinars through the BON course catalog. You will receive a purchase confirmation and event reminders via your email address, leading up to the scheduled activity, and post activity reminders in order to help you receive your CNE certificate or certificate of completion. Webinar attendance may require some advance technical preparation. Instructions and help for confirming that your workstation is compatible with the online webinar process are provided for each event. The Board also recommends joining at least 15 minutes early to ensure that you can attend the entire webinar. All of the BON CNE activities include online components that must be completed in conjunction with the activity in order to receive completion credit and certificates. When you register online, a BON Lifelong Learning Account is created and that will be your home for all BON continuing education courses, workshops and webinars.

Depending on the continuing education course, you may be required to log into your individual account to complete follow-up learning activities and/or course evaluations after a workshop or webinar in order to receive your CNE certificate or certificate of completion.

The BON Lifelong Learning Account will also contain links for workshop handouts, any required forms, post-activity certificates of completion, and other helpful resources for each registered activity. If questions arise during your registration or during an online learning course, there are specific **Help** links throughout the process to direct you to the dedicated Online Learning Help Desk.

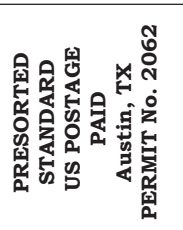

BON Continuing Competency Offerings Address New Nursing Jurisprudence and Ethics Requirements

In 2013, the 83rd Regular Texas Legislative Session passed a law that specifies new continuing education requirements for all nurses. Senate Bill (SB) 1058 requires nurses to complete at least 2 hours of continuing education related to nursing jurisprudence and ethics before the end of every third, two-year licensing period. The BON has two continuing education offerings which meet the new requirements: the workshop titled, "Protecting Your Patients and Your Practice" and the interactive online CNE Opportunity titled, "Nursing Regulations for Safe Practice".
