The mission of the Texas Board of Nursing is to protect and promote the welfare of the people of Texas by ensuring that each person holding a license as a nurse in the State of Texas is competent to practice safely. The Board fulfills its mission through the regulation of the practice of nursing and the approval of nursing education programs. This mission, derived from the Nursing Practice Act, supersedes the interest of any individual, the nursing profession, or any special interest group.

Texas 2016 NCLEX® Pass Rates Higher Than National Average

The NCLEX® examination pass rates for Texas-approved nursing education programs for the past five (5) years are provided on the Board of Nursing (BON) website (www.bon.texas.gov) under the *Education* link. The pass rates are calculated for vocational (VN) and for professional (RN: diploma, associate degree, baccalaureate, and entry-level master's degree) nursing education programs based upon the examination year:

- * VN examination year: January 1 through December 31
- * RN examination year: October 1 through September 30

Only first-time candidates who test during the examination year are included in the pass rate. Considering only first-time candidates provides an indication of the effects of the nursing education on student success on the examination. Research has shown that

graduates who take the exam within a few months after program completion are more likely to pass than those who delay taking the examination.

The Texas 2016 NCLEX-RN® examination pass rate for all RN programs was 87.14% (higher than the national average of 84.30%). Forty-eight RN programs in Texas had a 90% or higher pass rate. Six RN programs had a 100% pass rate.

The 2016 NCLEX-PN® examination pass rates will be presented to the BON members at the April 2017 meeting. Tentative information indicates that the pass rate for all VN programs in Texas will be 87.50% (higher than the national average of 83.70%). Preliminary data also indicate that 52 VN programs had a pass rate of 90% or higher, with 24 of the 52 VN programs having a pass rate of 100%.

Desiree Casey

During the month of July 2016, Desiree Casey represented herself as a school nurse at a school in McLennan County, Texas, without having a license to practice professional or vocational nursing in the State of Texas. The case was referred to the McLennan County District Attorney's Office.



Blanca Mata

On June 15, 2016, Blanca Mata was indicted in the United States District Court for the Northern District of Texas, Dallas Division, for health care fraud and conspiracy to commit health care fraud. The indictment alleged that, between January 2010 and April 2015, Blanca Mata was an employee of a medical house call service in the Dallas area, and portrayed herself as a nurse practitioner, physician assistant, or physician to patients of the medical house call service. Blanca Mata is not licensed to practice professional or advanced practice registered nursing in the State of Texas.



Roseline Oluchi Okoro

Roseline Oluchi Okoro secured employment and practiced as a registered nurse (RN) with a mental health outpatient facility in Houston, Texas, between November 30, 2016 and December 20, 2016, by using an invalid license. Ms. Okoro listed her nursing license as being in current status when hired, but failed to inform the clinical director that she surrendered her nursing license on May 5, 2016. This case has been referred to the Harris County District Attorney's Office.



Dinah Shaw

During the month of July 2016, Dinah Shaw represented herself as a school nurse and used the title "Nurse Shaw" at a school in McLennan County, Texas, without having a license to practice professional or vocational nursing in the State of Texas. The case was referred to the McLennan County District Attorney's Office.



Minerva Valdez

a.k.a. **Minerva Y. Gonzalez**

In May 2016 through October 2016, Minerva Valdez secured employment as a registered nurse (RN) with several different hospice and home health agencies and health clinics in the McAllen, Edinburg, Edcouch, and Pharr areas. Ms. Valdez is not licensed to practice professional nursing in the State of Texas. She used the name and RN license number belonging to a licensee with a similar name but a different social security number. This case has been referred to the Hidalgo County District Attorney's Office.

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Summary of Actions

A regular meeting of the Board of Nursing was held January 19-20 2017, in Austin. The following is a summary of Board actions taken during this meeting.



In the February 3, 2017 issue of the *Texas Register*, the Board of Nursing published notice of intention to review and consider for re-adoption, re-adoption with amendments, or repeal: Chapter 214. *Vocational Nursing Education*, Chapter 215. *Professional Nursing Education*, and Chapter 222. *Advanced Practice Registered Nurses with Prescriptive Authority* with 30 days to comment and submit responses or suggestions. APRNs Must Include Delegating Physician Information on Prescriptions

Advanced practice registered nurses (APRNs) with prescriptive authority are authorized to issue prescription drug orders. Their prescriptions must comply with the requirements set forth by the Texas State Board of Pharmacy and must also include the information required in Section 157.056 of the Texas Occupations Code and reiterated in Board Rule 222.4(b). Among the requirements found in this rule is the requirement that prescriptions issued by

APRNs include the name, address, and telephone number of the physician with whom the APRN has a prescriptive authority agreement or facility-based protocol. Pharmacists are required to comply with the pharmacy laws and rules when filling prescriptions and must refuse to fill prescriptions issued by APRNs if the delegating physician's name and contact information are not included on the prescription [22 Tex. Admin. Code, §§291.34(b)(7)(A) and

295.3]. This leads to delays in patients receiving their prescribed medications. Such delays can easily be prevented by providing the required name and contact information of the delegating physician when the prescription is issued. This allows both the APRN and the pharmacist to be in compliance with state law as well as the rules governing their respective practices.



Advisory Committee Updates



New Members to Advisory Committee on Education Appointed at the October 2016 Board Meeting

The Advisory Committee on Education (ACE) advises the Board of Nursing (Board) on education and practice issues that have or may have an impact on the regulation of nursing education in Texas. The Texas Association of Vocational Nurse Educators (TAVNE) and the Texas League for Nursing (TLN) are two of the organizations with representation on the committee.

Betty E. Sims, EdD, MSN, RN, FRE honorably served as the TAVNE representative to ACE from 2008 until her passing in April 2016. April Ernst, MSN, RN, CNE, current president of TAVNE was nominated by TAVNE and approved by the Board to represent TAVNE on ACE. Ms. Ernst has extensive experience in nursing education, both in faculty and director roles. Currently, she is an independent consultant for nursing education programs and has authored several nursing education program proposals that have been approved by the Board. Ms. Ernst has served on ACE since 2015, representing TAVNE-Hospital Based Programs, and is active in many professional nursing associations. She also served on the Board workgroup that developed the Differentiated Essential Competencies of Graduates of Texas Nursing Programs and the Deferred Disciplinary Action Pilot Program.

Alyce Ashcraft, PhD, RN, CNE, FNGNA, ANEF, was nominated by TLN and was approved by the Board as the representative for TLN on ACE. Dr. Ashcraft currently serves as Associate Dean for Research and Professor of Nursing at Texas Tech University Health Sciences Center School of Nurs-

ing. Dr. Ashcraft is an experienced educator, researcher, and practitioner who has held a variety of distinguished positions in academic and practice settings.

Dr. Ashcraft's scholarly activities include several grant funded research projects including current research entitled, *Improving Nurse Physician Communication in the Nursing Home*, funded through Sigma Theta Tau International Honor Society and the National Gerontological Nursing Association. She has published numerous abstracts, articles, and editorials in various national peer reviewed nursing journals.

Dr. Ashcraft is a national and international presenter and an active member of several nursing associations and committees. She has received many honors and awards throughout her career, including the 2016 Chancellor's Council Distinguished Research Award at Texas Tech University Health Sciences Center.

New Member to Nursing Practice Advisory Committee Appointed at the January 2017 Board Meeting

The Nursing Practice Advisory Committee (NPAC) reviews and analyzes issues that affect the practice of nursing. The Texas Hospital Association (THA) is one of the organizations with representation on the committee. Elizabeth Sjoberg, RN, JD, very ably served as the THA representative to NPAC for many years and has retired. Cyndy Dunlap, DNP, RN, NEA-BC, FACHE was nominated by THA and was approved by the Board of Nursing as the represen-

tative for the Texas Hospital Association on NPAC.

She is a healthcare executive with over twenty years of experience promoting excellence in the delivery of care to patients through achievement of clinical, financial, and operational strategies and goals. Texas Center for Nursing Workforce Studies Serves as Nursing Workforce Data Resource

In 2004, in response to mounting concern about Texas' nurse shortage, the Texas Legislature created the Texas Center for Nursing Workforce Studies (TCNWS) under the governance of the Statewide Health Coordinating Council (SHCC). The TCNWS serves as a resource for data and research on the nursing workforce in Texas. The TCNWS is charged to collect and analyze data and publish reports related to educational and employment trends of nursing professionals, the supply and demand of nursing professionals, nursing workforce demographics, migration of nursing professionals, and other issues concerning nursing professionals in Texas as determined necessary by the TCNWS Advisory Committee and SHCC.

One of the roles of the TCNWS includes collaboration and coordination with other organizations that gather and use nursing workforce data, such as the Texas Board of Nursing (Board), the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board, Texas Nurses Association, Texas Hospital Association, and regional healthcare organizations and educational councils. This coordination is needed in order to avoid duplication of efforts in gathering data; to avoid overloading employers and educators with completing a large number of duplicate surveys; to share resources in the development and implementation of studies; and to establish better sources of data and methods for providing data to legislators, policy makers and key stakeholders.

The TCNWS team works closely with the Board Education Department in the development and dissemination of the Nursing Education Program Information Survey (NEPIS) and the Compliance Audit for Nursing Education Programs (CANEP). The NEPIS is designed to collect demographic data and is distributed annually, whereas the CANEP

is intended to measure a program's compliance with Board rules and regulations and is distributed every other year, during odd-numbered years.

Currently, three distinct NEPIS instruments are utilized, crafted specifically to elicit information from vocational nursing education programs (VN-NEPIS), professional nursing education programs (RN-NEPIS), and graduate nursing education programs (G-NEPIS). The G-NEPIS gathers data from Advanced Practice Nursing Education (APRN) Programs to include the four APRN roles: nurse anesthetist, nurse-midwife, nurse practitioner, and clinical nurse specialist. Further, this survey is sent to programs offering graduate degrees in nursing administration, nursing informatics, nursing research, nursing practice, nursing education, clinical nurse leader, and public health nursing.

The NEPIS obtains data specific to curriculum, program tracks, advanced placement options, online availability, as well as faculty and student attributes. The survey outcomes assist in projecting future workforce needs for nursing education programs in the state. Data have been collected and analyzed since 2006 that can be used to evaluate nursing education trends.

The CANEP requires the program dean or director to attest to adherence to Board rules and regulations through responses to a series of approximately 60 questions/statements and also collects information via the CANEP Supplemental Survey. The addendum requests information about non-nursing faculty, clinical teaching assistants, program support faculty, in-state clinical sites, out-of-state clinical sites, and curriculum analysis.

After collaboration with Board staff

members to collect NEPIS data, TCNWS staff members analyze results and publish the following yearly reports for each of the three levels of nursing education: Vocational, Professional, and Graduate. The 2015 reports concerning (1) Program Characteristics; (2) Admission, Enrollment, and Graduation Trends; (3) Student Demographics; and (4) Faculty Demographics are accessible from the Board website at:

Prescription Monitoring Program Registration

Senate Bill 305 (85th Texas Legislature) proposes to amend the Nursing Practice Act to require all advanced practice registered nurses (APRNs) who prescribe opioids, benzodiazepines, barbiturates, or carisoprodol to check the prescription monitoring program (PMP) before writing prescriptions for drugs in these categories. All APRNs who have prescriptive authority and a United States Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) registration number may register to use the PMP through the Texas State Board of Pharmacy's (TSBP's) website. AWARe is a PMP that allows health care providers to query patient reports of controlled substance

prescriptions in an effort to help them safely prescribe controlled substances. The PMP helps prescribers avoid practices such as polypharmacy in which duplicate prescriptions may be issued for the same drug by multiple providers. APRNs and other prescribers may also query the PMP to evaluate their own prescribing practices. This allows a prescriber to confirm that all prescriptions for controlled substances linked to the provider's prescriber identification were actually written by that prescriber. Imposter Follow-Up: Juan Manuel Perez

A San Benito man, Juan Manuel Perez, 36, as initially reported in the July 2016 issue of the *Board of Nursing Bulletin*, pleaded guilty to using another man's identity so he could pose as a licensed vocational nurse (LVN). Perez posed as a nurse when he made home visits and gave nursing care to patients of a health care company from December 2015 through July 2016. U.S. District Judge Micaela Alvarez sentenced Mr. Perez to 24 months of confinement in federal prison. Judge Alvarez stated that Mr. Perez's misappropriation of the LVN's identity had denied patients the right to receive health care from a licensed professional.


